School and community health will get a big boost this fall thanks to Hawai'i health and education leaders. Elementary and middle school students and faculty can receive **FREE** flu vaccines at school during the day. Parent/guardian permission is required.

Families can choose the injectable or nasal spray flu vaccine (FluMist®). There are important differences between the two, so read your vaccine information packet carefully. If you need a new one, contact your child's school.
